

Scholarship / Freeship Scheme for Lingaya's University
(Applicable for B.Tech)

The details about various scholarships and freeships (as per the new rules decided in a meeting of Board of Management) are as follows.

1. Gold / Silver / Bronze Medalist Awards:

On completion of program of study (for first three position holders)

- a. First prize carries a gold medal, certificate and cash prize of Rs.10, 000/-
- b. Second prize shall carry a silver medal, certificate and cash prize of Rs7500/-
- c. Third prize shall carry a bronze medal, certificate and cash prize of Rs.5000/-

2. Scholarship for Branch Toppers:

During the first year and on completion of every consecutive academic year (for the topper * of each branch)

Topper of each branch shall be awarded scholarship of Rs.40, 000/- and certificate of merit for that academic year

(* Topper for first year would be decided on the basis of marks obtained by the student in Class 12th and topper for subsequent years would be decided on the basis of performance / result of the previous academic year)

NOTE:

1. The above scholarships would be awarded if the minimum students in the branch are 60
2. No scholarship if the combined TGPA is less than 6.75/first division
3. Student is not eligible, if student fail in any course and earns less than the recommended credit
4. No scholarship/certificate in case of any disciplinary case against the position holder.

3. Merit scholarships

Five percent of students sanctioned strength of each discipline / program will be awarded merit scholarship of Rs. 5000/- per annum on the performance in the qualifying examination for the program subject to the condition that the student has secured not less than 80% marks in aggregate / CGPA of 9.0.

This will continue till the student completes his/her program of studies, provided that he/she does not fail in any course and secures a minimum of 6.75 TGPA annually in recommended credits in each term/academic year of the concerned programme.

One student can avail only one scholarship at a time, if he is eligible for more than one scholarship as mentioned above (Point 2 to 3)

4. Interest free need based loan :

Up to 5% of students sanctioned strength in a programme may be granted interest free need based loan. The amount of loan shall not exceed 66% of the tuition fee and same shall be decided on case to case basis. The student will be required to repay in eight equal half yearly installments, beginning from a year after he/she completes programme. The academic performance and the financial background or any other circumstance will be the determining factors for such loans.

5. Fee concession under Employee Welfare:

Concession of 25% of tuition fee for first child of employee of Lingaya's University with a monthly salary of less than equal to Rs. 15000/- will be given while for other employees the concession of 15% of the tuition fee will be given. For availing this facility, the employee should have minimum of 3 year service in Lingaya's University.

6. Sponsored Medal

The university may accept proposal from NGOs, Philanthropist and other organization / individuals for institution of medals/scholarship to promote merit in specific areas like sports, community service etc. and the same may be awarded as and when such schemes are instituted for which separate guidelines may be formulated.

Important Note (Applicable to all above scholarships / freeships).

- The award continuation of the various concessions enumerated above shall be subjected to exemplary conduct & behavior of the student in and outside the University campus.
- In case a student is eligible for more than one scholarship/freeship etc. from all sources, he/she shall be awarded only one such concession as per his/her preference.
