Up to 10% relaxation in eligibility criteria for NRI quota seats in B.Tech, B.Arch courses only.

- a) The Candidates appearing in the qualifying examination are also eligible to apply provided they are able to produce the proof of having acquired minimum prescribed qualifications at the time of admission.
- b) If the total result of qualifying examination is not declared by the concerned Board/University till the date of admission his/her admission in that case will be provisional subject to the following conditions:
 - i. The candidate will have to submit the result of qualifying examination proving his/her eligibility on or before **30-09-2011**.

- ii. In case the candidate fails to submit his/her final result of qualifying examination in the manner prescribed under (i) above to prove his/her eligibility on or before **30-09-2011**, what so ever the reason may be, his/her admission will be treated as null and void and the entire fee will be forfeited.
- c) It is further clarified that provisional admission will be considered only in such cases where the result of the qualifying examination has not been declared by the concerned Board/University in its totality. In case the result has been declared by the concerned Board/University but it has not been declared in a specific case, for any reason, such case will NOT be considered under provisional admission category.

There will be no rounding-off of the percentage of marks of qualifying examination while deciding the basic eligibility of any candidate for admission.

MIGRATION TO SECOND YEAR OF B.TECH / MBA / MCA FROM OTHER RECOGNISED UNIVERSITIES

REFUND OF FEE

The admitted candidate who wishes to withdraw his/her candidature should apply for withdrawal of admission by due date (Refer to chapter 'Key Dates'). Such candidates will be refunded the fee deposited by them after deducting Rupees One Thousands only if they apply for refund before the start of session. Should a student leave after joining the course and only if the seat consequently falling vacant has been filled by another candidate by the last date of admission, the Institution would return the fee collected with proportionate deductions of monthly fee and proportionately hostel rent, bus fee etc.

NO REQUEST FOR WITHDRAWAL OF ADMISSION SHALL BE ENTERTAINED AFTER THE LAST DATE OF WITHDRAWAL, WHATSOEVER BE THE REASON. However, all eligible refund would be process after the end of admission.

PHYSICAL FITNESS

The applicant must be in good mental and physical health and should be free from any physical defect which is likely to interfere with his/her studies including active outdoor duties required of a professional. Accordingly, all the students shall be required to submit Medical Certificate indicating fitness from a Registered Medical Practitioner as per format given in Appendix II

AGE LIMIT

The upper age limit for admission to all the courses, which eligibility criteria as 10+2 is 21 years. However, there is no upper age limit for other courses.

ADDITIONAL INTAKE

There is supernumerary quota for wards of Persons of Indian Origin, female candidates, economically weaker section, physically handicapped meritorious students and Kashmiri migrants as per MHRD guidelines.
